


Over 1000 of Regit's registered car owners completed this survey.



Charging Point








How long would you be willing to wait for an 80% charge on your car (from 0%) at a public charging point?




Of car owners are in a position where a domestic charge point could be installed. e.g on your driveway or in your garage






Which of these issues will prevent you from owning an electric car?





Theoretically, how many miles would an electric car need to be capable of (on one full battery) for you to consider it a viable replacement for your petrol or diesel car?






